



A message from Owner and Managing Director:

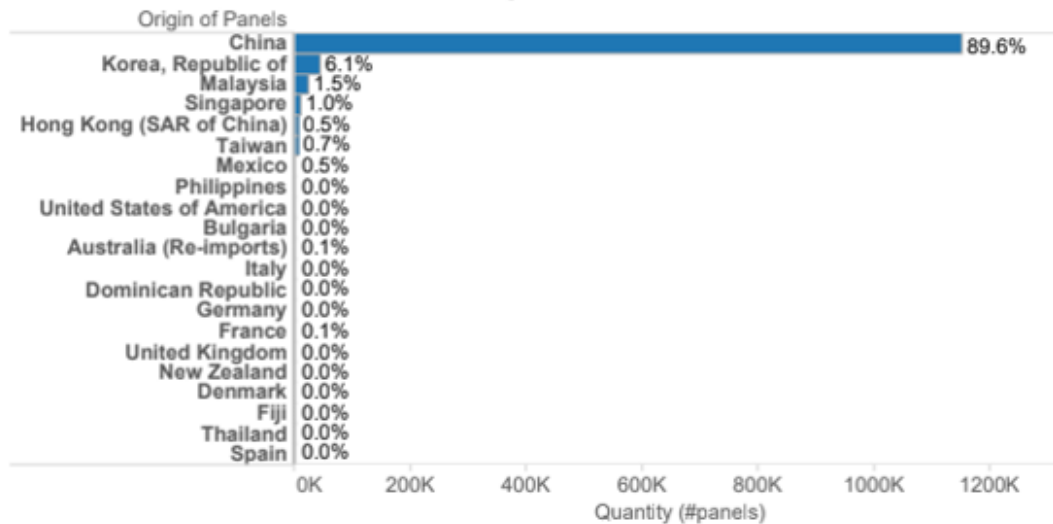
