Refurbishment of Port Davis Jetty

Port Davis Jetty will be completely refurbished to create a safer, more sustainable area for fishing.

The Jetty will be transformed through the replacement of piles and decking at the end of the Jetty, new stairs and hand railing, all of which will use a fibre glass product.

The contractor performing the works specialises in maritime infrastructure and is known for many successful jetty repairs and refurbishments both locally and throughout South Australia.

Works are scheduled to start in **early to mid March and expected to be completed by the end of the month**. During this time, there will be no access to Port Davis Jetty, however, there will still be access to the southern half of the neighbouring boat ramp. Council thanks the community for their patience during the closures.

The Jetty will be fully reopened for use in mid to late March 2019, subject to favourable weather conditions.
