Port Pirie: Best Grey Nomad Experience in South Australia

Port Pirie has been named as the 'not to be missed' experience for mature-age visitors travelling South Australia.

The Spencer Gulf town in the Flinders Ranges and Outback tourism region was announced as the Best Grey Nomad Experience in South Australia at the Grey Nomad Awards tonight.

It nudged out six other South Australian finalists to receive the State Award and also received the Bronze Award nationally for Best Grey Nomad Friendly Town.

The Grey Nomad Awards shine a light on regional Australia by showcasing the very best places to stay and play, while supporting positive aging through soft adventure and social inclusion.

With rigorous judging by mature-age tourism professionals, some of whom have experienced the grey nomad lifestyle personally, plus second-tier auditing, social analysis and due diligence, Port Pirie's win has the credence of the tourism sector.

Port Pirie is the perfect SA destination for travellers seeking a rich blend of history, culture, and natural beauty as this welcoming seaport town boasts a diverse range of activities and experiences.

For history enthusiasts, Port Pirie offers captivating museums, a self-guided heritage walk, and an array of heritage buildings. Art lovers can explore the Port Pirie Regional Art Gallery (where you'll find the Visitor Centre) with its ever-changing exhibitions, and a Mural Trail that adorns the CBD.

The town also offers stunning parks and gardens, cycling trails, and excellent shopping, dining, and café experiences, while nature lovers will revel in the stunning landscapes, with the Flinders Ranges and Outback nearby, making Port Pirie an excellent base for scenic drives.

Australians aged over 55 represent one of the biggest opportunities in domestic tourism. According to the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS), they possess 32% of Australia's disposable income along with the flexibility and motivation to travel.

Awards Director, Kim Morgan, said the Awards provide verified information for this important segment, helping guide their decisions on where to visit and what to include on a must-see extended Australian road trip in 2024.

"As a nation, our love of the open road has never dimmed, and with Australia being a big country it's important to know where to visit to have extraordinary experiences. That's where the Grey Nomad Awards come into play," Ms Morgan said.

In commenting, the judges said, "Port Pirie has considered every aspect of the RV traveller journey and understands that it is often the small things that combine to make an epic experience which encourage travellers to stay longer, spend more and return."

"In Port Pirie's case this includes not-so-glamorous but necessary facilities, such as free dump points and potable water, plus long vehicle parking, easy access to shopping and medical facilities, as well as a list of reliable and swift-to-respond mechanical services," the judges said.
