1. PURPOSE

Vandalism is an enormous cost to Councils. This policy allows for quick action in establishment of a reward which could assist the capture of vandals and therefore discourage further vandalism.

2. SCOPE

All of the area of the Port Pirie Regional Council.

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4. POLICY STATEMENT

- 4.1 Council encourages the general public to report instances of vandalism to the Authorities or Council's Administration. A reward of "up to" \$1,000 may be offered to any member of the public whose report of vandalism results in the conviction of a person or persons responsible.
- 4.2 A Committee comprising the Mayor, Chief Executive Officer and the Officer in Charge of Police are authorised to establish a reward up to the above limit.
- 4.3 In the event of a major act of vandalism, Council may increase the amount of reward offered.
