

Extension of Shared Pathway on Three Chain Road, Port Pirie



Port Pirie Regional Council plans to extend its shared walking / cycling path network along Three Chain Road from Simpson Road through to Afford Road.

The extension of the shared path will be a 3m wide continuation of the existing pathway network which links to the Port Pirie Riverbank Precinct and will provide additional space for pedestrians and cyclists to utilise.

The project will involve:

- Shoulder widening of the road to accommodate the shared path
- Removal of existing timber bollards and guard rails
- Base preparation of the new path
- Asphaltting
- Construction of kerb ramps
- Line marking
- Installation of new signage, bollards and refuge rails.



This project has been made possible with funding from the 2023/24 State Bicycle Fund and the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure (LRCI) Program Phase 4B
