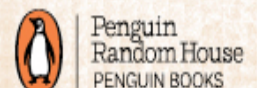

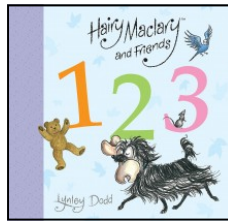

Learn your 123 with help from the mischievous Hairy Maclary and his rollicking gang of friends.



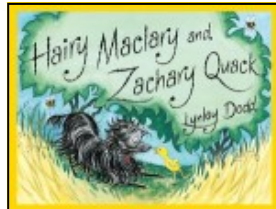
Slinky Malinki is an adventurous cat, cheeky and cheerful, friendly and fun. But at night he becomes a thief.

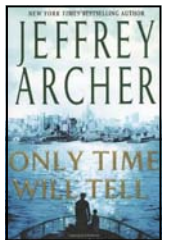

■What's it about?

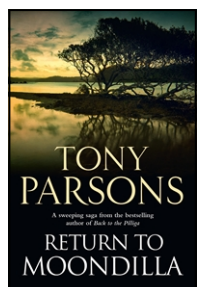
I've only just started but it's the first of a eight book series that tells the story of one family across generations, across oceans, from heartbreak to triumph.
